Rules and Regulations:

To insure a safe and successful parade, parade participants must adhere to the following.

- 1) No one will be allowed to drive a vehicle in the parade without a valid Georgia Drivers License and must be over the age of 18. No tractor-trailers allowed.
- 2) When children are riding on floats and vehicles they must be accompanied by a minimum of two adults
- 3) It is requested that all entries be decorated to theme – A Southern Christmas.
- 4) Participants who act, use music, or language that is deemed to be offensive by the organizers (Covington Lion's Club & Main Street) will be removed from the parade.
- 5) All entries must be lined up and in position as directed by the committee no later than 10.30am. **If you want your entry judged you must be in the line-up by 9:00am.**
- 6) One decorated float is allowed per commercial entry, unless the committee has granted prior approval.
- 7) Candy **cannot** be thrown from floats. Walkers through the parade route can pass candy or favors.
- 8) Drivers of all vehicles will adhere to parade committee instructions at all times and will follow the directions of the parade route, maintaining a distance of 30 feet between vehicles.
- 9) Participants are to have an easily read banner with the group's name on right side of the vehicle. A parade number will be issued at the line-up.
- 10) All animals must be on a leash or rein at all times.
- 11) There is to be only one Santa in the parade, he is the guest of Main Street Covington, the City of Covington, and the Covington Lion's Club.
- 12) Distribution of handbills, pamphlets and other literature is prohibited. This is a litter free event
- 13) Rules and liability waiver signed.

Participants failing to adhere to these rules may be removed from the parade

Parade Categories

Best All-Around Trophy- the float deemed to be the best over all in terms of holiday spirit, theme, creativity, and construction

(This trophy will be awarded at the reviewing stand upon arrival of the float at the Newton County Historical Courthouse.)

School Awards- 1st and 2nd place awards for elementary, middle, and high schools, preschools, and day cares

Horse Awards- Best Tack, Rider Dress, and Best Group

(Butt bags must be worn or scooper provided.)

Other Categories- Churches, civic clubs, Boys and Girls Scouts, corporate, and golf carts

Procedure

Judged entries must be in line-up by 9:00 am

All entries must be in line up by 10:00 am

Parade begins at 10:30 am

Lineup is on Newton Dr. - enter ONLY from Mill St.

(Note: route changed from last year; the distance is the same)

Parade moves Newton Dr. W. to Anderson St. to Floyd St. W.

West on Floyd St. to Covington Square

Around square onto Church St.

Proceed across tracks to Mill St.

Turn L on Mill St. to fairgrounds

There is no fee to enter the parade. If your group is raising funds during the parade, please consider making a donation to the Covington Lion's Club on the day of the parade.

Any additional donations would be gratefully received for Lion's Work.

All entries in the parade must be decorated in the spirit of the parade (i.e. - more than just a wreath hanging on the front).

Entries must be received or postmarked by November 23, 2011.

The parade is limited to 120 entries.
